Can you see where the following words are repeated?

- visit - salvation - prophets

- saved (delivered) - promise/oath

How do these observations help you see the message more clearly?

INTERPRETATION: What does it mean?

What do you think 'horn of salvation' means in Luke 1:69?

Why does Zechariah focus on the 'holy covenant' that God made with their fathers?

According to Luke 1:74-75, why have we been saved?

According to Luke 1:78-79, why did Jesus come to this earth? What does this mean for you today in relationship with God?

APPLICATION: What difference does it make? How does this affect me? What can I do this week?

How can you rely on the promises of God? How can you celebrate them?

Are there times when you lose sight of the salvation that God has given to us? How can you recapture the wonder and appreciation towards him?

There is celebration of God's prophets who communicate God's message. How can you look deeper into what they have said? How can their words help shape your existing relationship with Christ?

Reflect on the way that God has saved you. How did this take place for you? Share this with others in order to encourage.

Do you 'visit' with God? How does he guide you into the 'way of peace'?
