Our Purpose (Why do we exist?)

We exist to love God and love others (Matthew 22:37-40)

Our Mission (What are we to do?)

TEFC is to make disciples of Jesus Christ who know God, grow to be like Christ, and go in the Spirit to make disciples (Matthew 28:18-20)

Our Vision (Where are we headed?)

Helping Taber and the world say, "Yes" to Jesus.

- Saying "Yes" to Jesus in knowing God deeply, responding to the Gospel, thriving on his Word, obeying his commands, and walking with him daily.
- Saying "Yes" to Jesus in his challenge to live as his disciples, growing to be like him in character and in living.
- Saying "Yes" to Jesus in following his command to go and make disciples, serving the needs of our neighbors, living in genuine community, and proclaiming the Gospel throughout the world.

Our Values

(What is important as we fulfill purpose/mission/vision?)

Gospel Centredness

The Gospel is the Good News about Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:1-5). There is no other message and truth by which we are saved. We value the Gospel because this news is our only hope in life and death and the best truth that we can offer to a lost world.

Scripture

The Bible is valued because it is God's Word to us; words that carry the greatest weight, communicate the greatest truth, and direct us in the greatest ways as our sole authority.

Prayer

We value a life of prayer for every disciple of Jesus. Prayer calls out to God in dependence, thankfulness, and praise, fostering intimacy with God

Pelationshine


Disciples are called to be in loving relationships with others. We see developing and fostering relationships as essential for everyone who follows Christ.

Hospitality

Related to healthy relationships is seeking out others who are new or who do not know Jesus Christ. We value hospitality as a way of welcoming others with love and care.

Fruitfulness

Jesus tells us that we will be able to determine if people follow him by the fruit that is present in their lives (John 15). Helping others bear the fruit of obedience and trust is extremely important because it is fruitfulness that easily identifies someone as a genuine disciples of Jesus Christ.



New Sermon Series:

The Book of Acts

We are excited to start a new sermon series as a church this fall. For the next few months, we will journey together through the Book of Acts. This book of the Bible was chosen for some important reasons that will be helpful to remember as we move through the book.

Acts Highlights the Work of the Holy Spirit

We have just come through the book of Galatians with its emphasis on freedom and walking with the Holy Spirit. In Acts, we see how the Holy Spirit powerfully lives and works in the disciples. It is the Holy Spirit who helps the disciples and the early church bear witness of Jesus Christ, give discernment at crucial growth points in the

church, and shape the church to be everything that Jesus died for.

Acts Depicts What Discipleship Looks Like

As the Spirit works in the church and in people's lives, we see portraits of discipleship in the lives of Jesus' followers. We will see that discipleship involves remaining faithful in the midst of difficulty, submitting to the direction of the Spirit, telling others about Jesus, caring tangibly for others, and working together in community. The various vignettes into the lives of the disciples spark our own imaginations with how discipleship can look for us today.

Acts Outlines How the Church Fulfills Its Mission


In Acts, we see the church experience new growth and sustained health. This is largely due to the way that the church strives hard to fulfill the mission that Jesus gave to keep making more disciples.
