

Resurrection Change - Luke 24:36-49

- 1. READ Luke 24:36-49
- 2. LOOK What do I see?

What details stand out to you in this story? What do you notice? What does Jesus say to his disciples?

3. THINK - What does it mean?

What do you think it means for Jesus to address the disciples' doubt? How does he help them?

REMEMBER (from the sermon):

Jesus' resurrection changes your worldview, your understanding, and your direction. You will either believe or reject the reality of the resurrection.

What does Jesus mean when he speaks about "everything written about me in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms" (Lk 24:44)?

What does it mean for the disciples to be a witness? What is the "power from on high" (Lk 24:49)? How does this help?

4. APPLY - What difference does it make?

Does the resurrection affect your worldview?
Do you have doubts about the resurrection?
How do you address them?

Does the resurrection affect your understanding? How can you read the Bible differently, based on how Jesus instructs the disciples?

Does the resurrection affect your direction? How can you be a witness to others? Have you experienced the Holy Spirit helping you to be a witness to others?

5. PRAY - How can you pray?
